

## 80 HOME LEARNING

- We operate a two-week timetable, green week and yellow week.
- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January is green week.
- Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January – Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> January is yellow week.
- This will then rotate until February half term. School closes for half-term on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February.
- Lessons will take place at the following times and will last up to 40 minutes:
  - P.1 9.10 am
  - P.2 10.10 am
  - P.3 11.30 am
  - P.4 12.30 pm
  - P.5 1.50 pm

### Expectations of pupils:

- Pupils are expected to participate in Live online lessons. An attendance register will be taken for monitoring purposes.
- Pupils are expected to complete assignments which are set on Teams and the work needs to be submitted to teachers.
- Pupils can hand in completed work using the hand in function on Teams or by uploading a photo of the work to Teams. They could also email a photo of the work to their teacher.
- Pupils must submit work on the day it is set. The work can be done at a different time of the day, so an assignment lesson could be completed at 6 pm if this is more suitable. However all work which needs to be handed in should be submitted by the end of that day.

### Expectations of teaching staff:

- Teachers will be available on Teams to answer any questions and to support learning during lessons which are set as assignments.
- Live online lessons may be delivered live by the class teacher\*, be pre-recorded, or be Oak National Academy lessons. Teachers will always be online at these times and will respond to Q+A.
- Teachers will acknowledge all work which is submitted and will provide feedback in relation to key pieces.

### Communication with parents:

- A member of staff will contact each pupil's parents/carers on a weekly basis to discuss engagement in learning and any other issue which may arise.
