Independent Learning:

- Regular vocab & grammar learning tasks - set of words, phrases or verbs to learn which will be tested in class
- Other tasks (reading, listening, writing & vocab) to practise language taught in lessons
- Revision tasks in preparation for assessments (speaking, listening, reading & writing)

• **How to help at home:**

- Test your child on their vocab regularly. Each student has a vocab booklet which contains the specification vocabulary
- Encourage your child to review language taught in class regularly at home – revisiting language little and often helps it stick into the long-term memory
- Ask to look at your child's exercise book and discuss work done in class with them – ask them to pronounce the words aloud to you
- Practice conversation questions with your child at home regularly
