In each unit of work, students will learn to:

- Demonstrate accurate understanding and accurate application of the grammar and vocabulary

Assessment:

- Vocab & grammar quizzes
- Mid-term speaking assessment (read aloud or questions & answers)
- End of term writing assessment (4 sentences about a photo & paragraph)
- End of term reading and listening assessment
- End of Year Exam

Independent Learning:

- Regular vocab learning tasks - set of words or phrases to learn from sentence builders which will be tested in class
- Other tasks (reading, writing & vocab) to practise language taught in lessons
- Revision tasks in preparation for assessments (speaking, listening, reading & writing)

How to help at home:

- Test your child on their vocab regularly. Core knowledge can be found in their Sentence Builder booklets
- Encourage your child to review language taught in class regularly at home – revisiting language little and often helps it stick into the long-term memory
- Ask to look at your child's exercise book and discuss work done in class with them – ask them to pronounce the words aloud to you
- Prior to writing and speaking assessments, ensure that your child has practised their sentences and is confident to speak/write them
