It is important that you are having discussions with your parents/carers about your options. Important points you can talk about are:

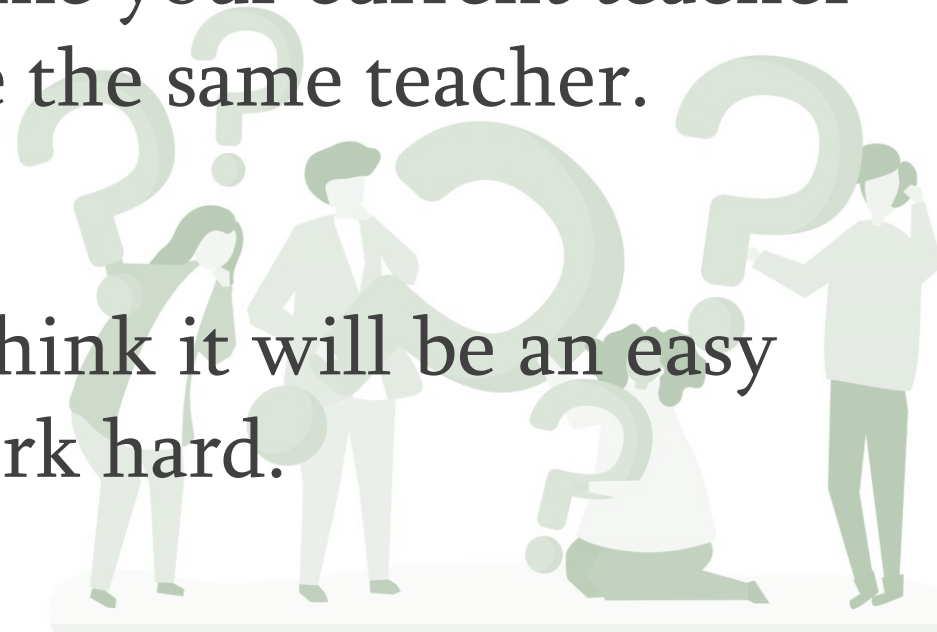
- What subjects am I interested in?

# What not to do...



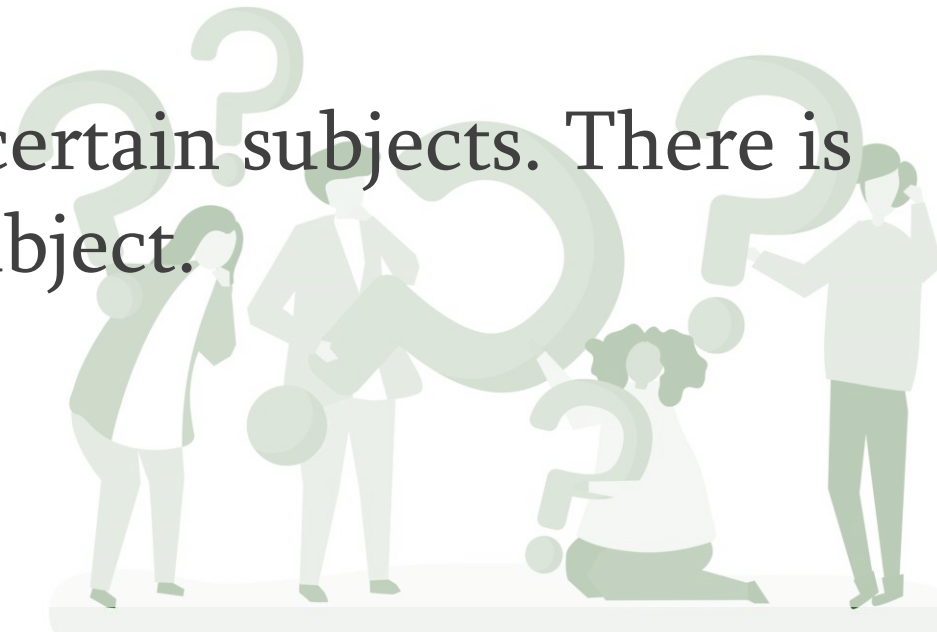
- Do not agree with your friends which subjects you will take together. Your choices need to be based on what is best for you.

- Do not choose a subject just because you think it will be an easy option. All subjects will require you to work hard.



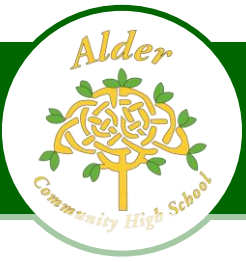
# What not to do...

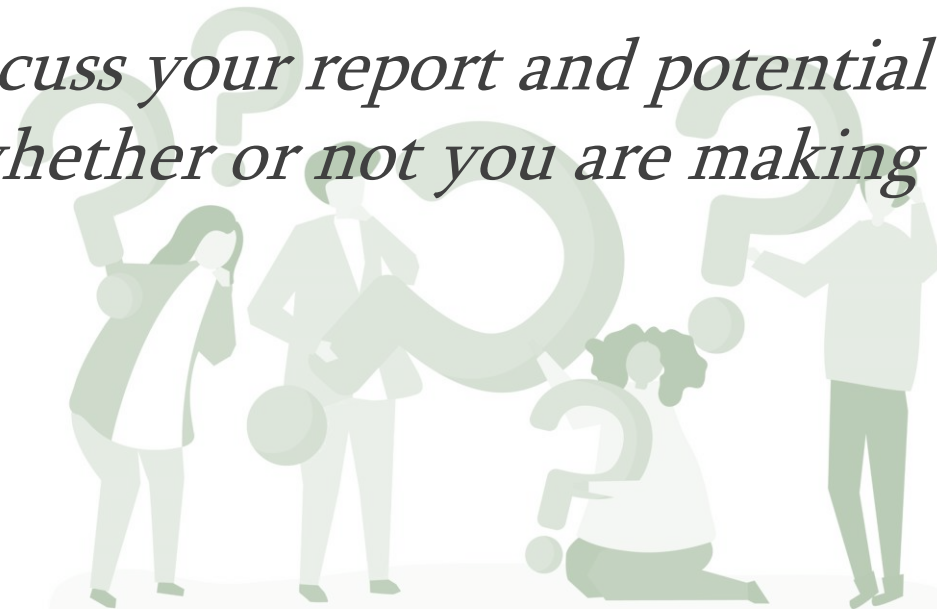
*You will find all the videos about each subject that you saw in form time and other information about how to complete the pathways form.*
