Harvest donations

We are very proud to support our local foodbank through our annual Harvest appeal. There are more families than ever before who are using and depending on a foodbank and I know that any contributions will be greatly appreciated. We talked about the work of foodbanks in our Monday collective worship and were particularly sad to see that between April 2023 and March 2024, 655,000 people found themselves using foodbanks for the first time. We also learnt that 1.1 million emergency food packages had been provided to

children during that period. We have placed our Harvest appeal collection box just inside the entrance lobby and children can also bring in donations to their classrooms.

Attendance

We take your child's attendance very seriously at Aldermaston CE Primary.

We are currently in the process of reviewing and updating our attendance policy. Based on new guidance from the Department for Education, these changes aim to promote and increase regular attendance and ensure that all students have the opportunity to reach their full potential by being in school more frequently.

The updated changes include the use of Penalty Notice Fines for absence from school. The changes have come in to use from 19th August 2024. Penalty Notice fines have increased to £160 for each parent, for each child.

NO NUTS STATEMENT

We have a responsibility to provide a safe learning environment for everyone in our school and we take the management of allergies very seriously.

As our school currently has one or more pupils on roll who suffer from a serious nut allergy, we request that parents and carers **DO NOT** send food to school that contains nuts. This includes:-

- All types of nuts
- Spreads and sandwich fillings containing nuts like peanut butter and Nutella
- Cereal and chocolate bars which contain nuts
- Cakes or biscuits which contain nuts

Car Park

Please be considerate when parking in our school grounds to drop off and collect your child. The spaces on the left hand side of the drive are meant to be used for people who can drop off or pick their child/children up quickly, rather than for those needing to wait for a long time. If you need to wait, please park in the spaces to the right of the main drive or in the spaces in front of the field to the left of the main school building as you come into the entrance gate. Thank you.

Use of Playground Equipment

We would ask that **NO CHILDREN** are allowed to play on the school equipment in and around the playground. These areas are for use by the children during school time only and should **NOT BE USED** by children before school or after school. Our insurance only covers the use of this equipment with supervision by staff, who are trained in the correct use of the play equipment and we would not want any harm to come to the children without the correct supervision.
