## Bikeability Charging

Bikeability is cycle training for the 21st Century. It is based on the government approved National Standards for cycle training. It is organised by West Berkshire Council and delivered at our schools by fully qualified and DBS checked Bikeability instructors.

Cycling is a life skill and provides a range of health and well-being benefits for everyone.

Courses currently available to West Berkshire schools include:

Bikeability Balance (Reception and Year 1)

Bikeability Level 1 (Year 5)

Bikeability Level 2 plus Bikeability Fix (Year 6\*),

Bikeability Level 3 (Year 6 onwards\*\*)

Bikeability Family (adults and up to 4 children\*\*\*)

Parents play an important role in ensuring the success of these courses.

These courses are NOT free (with the exception of Balance which we are fully funding). Once booked, West Berkshire Council has to pay each of the Instructors regardless of whether or not the training takes place. It is therefore very important that schools are able to provide the exact number of pupils who wish to take part in the cycle training.

The council heavily subsidise these courses to ensure every child in West Berkshire can access them.

The Level 1 and Level 2 courses each have a nominal booking fee of £10 per course per child. If a child fails to attend, the full cost of £73 may be chargeable to the school/parent.
