## Willink Peer Mentors visit

On Monday, the Starlings enjoyed a visit from the Willink Peer Mentors to help them prepare for transition to secondary school. It was a lovely day to be outside on the playground to chat with the mentors about the differences between primary and secondary schools. Our children reported that what they heard from the Peer Mentors really helped them. It was reassuring to be able to ask questions about homework, what to do if you get lost and other things that could cause them worry. It's also lovely to know that there are older children who will be looking out for them as they start secondary school.

## Scholastic book fair

The annual book fair is always a fantastic opportunity to promote reading with our children. Thank you for your help in allowing us to hold this event in a Covid safe way. Despite the changes, it was lovely to see the children so excited about picking out new books. We can't wait to hear how they are getting on with their books and whether they would recommend them to friends. The revenue raised for the school will also allow us to purchase some new stock for our library. In fact, Mrs Ebrey has been very busy with book ordering recently...

## Covid-19 safety

As you will have seen from recent letters, we have now had confirmation of a positive test result for Covid 19 in our school. If your child is an identified contact, you will already have been advised about isolation requirements.

This really does bring home the importance of staying vigilant and following measures to keep everyone safe. In school, staff continue to test twice a week using lateral flow device tests. We also continue to follow our risk assessment measures which include plenty of hand washing and extra cleaning. We're very grateful for everything you are doing to help us reduce the risk of Covid-19 infections. If your child starts to show potential Covid-19 symptoms, please do book a PCR test as soon as possible and let us know so we can start identifying contacts. Thank you.

## Year 6 fundraising

Our Year 6 Starlings Class were very keen to fit in one last fundraising opportunity before they move on to their secondary schools. They have chosen to champion the charity MIND which provides advice and support to anyone who might be experiencing a mental health problem.

They have produced a very professional video explaining the fund raising which has been shared with each class.

Wear face coverings (unless you are exempt)


Keep a safe distance from others on the school site and supervise children carefully
