#### **Hear the drums**

We recently welcomed Kakatsitsi, a group of master drummers from Ghana, to our school to share their musical and dancing talents.

They had the whole school on their feet dancing and singing! We learnt about how the music they shared was part of their Ghanaian tradition and how it reflected their daily lives and their beliefs.

The songs the children were taught became the soundtrack to our coach journeys this week – clear evidence of the children's enjoyment and the impact Kakatsitsi's visit had on them.



#### A whole school adventure

What an amazing day we had at our whole school trip to Go Ape this week. We were so pleased to be able to offer this adventurous activity to all the Aldermaston children. Our amazing children did brilliantly in facing the challenges of the obstacle course and quite often surprised themselves with what they could achieve. The games on the ground provided plenty of opportunities to develop teamwork and everyone appreciated the natural habitat of the forest and the time they spent in nature's playground. We know the children will have slept very well on Tuesday evening.

It was all hands on deck to ensure this trip could go ahead. Huge thanks to all of our staff team who made this ambitious plan possible and particularly Mrs Boyden for all of her work behind the scenes. See picture gallery later in this newsletter.

#### Mental health and wellbeing

We're proud of the provision that we already have in place to support the wellbeing of our children which has been a huge priority over the last couple of years. Staff have a real focus on pastoral care and implement a therapeutic thinking approach to behaviour management. We're also fortunate to have our own qualified ELSA (Mrs Woollam) available to work with children who need some additional support. We use our curriculum and special events like the annual healthy living week to provide additional input. However, we're always looking for ways to improve what we are doing and we wanted to update you on some new developments in this area.

Attached to this newsletter is an introduction from the Mental Health Support Team who will be working with the school from September this year. This is the second team set up in West Berkshire and this initiative will widen the options for support available to you, our staff and our children. I hope many of you will be able to attend the parent information session after the half term break

I am currently training to be a mental health lead for our school and the course is filled with interesting research about wellbeing and ideas for developing provision. At the same time, for their summer term project, our school council is looking at how we can help our children to enjoy better wellbeing and mental health. We'll have some more information about these developments on display at our family learning morning.

Thank you to everyone who has attended recent events in school including the parent sessions about the KS1 SATs and the phonics check and the excellent relaunch of our 'in person' reading café. It has been great to have you back in the building.
