Listen to others (don't interrupt)

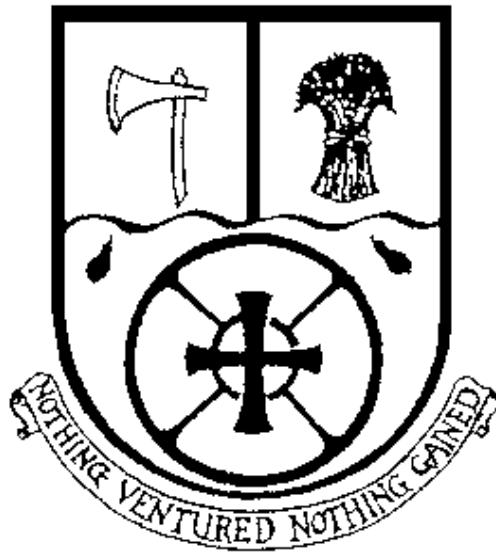
Look after property (don't damage things)
