## **INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT**

(made in accordance with s20 Education Act 2002 as amended)

- 1. The name of the school is Aldermaston Church of England Primary School
- 2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
- 3. The name of the Governing Body is 'The Governing Body of Aldermaston Church of England Primary School'
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - (a) two parent governors
  - (b) one LA governor
  - (c) one staff governor
  - (d) one head teacher
  - (e) two foundation governors
  - (f) five co-opted governors
- 5. The total number of governors shall be 12.
- 6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Diocese of Oxford.
- 7. The school was founded in 1838 and has a trust deed dated 12 August 1994.
- 8. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of The Church of England and in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan levels. The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
- 9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 20 January 2015.
- 10. This instrument was made by order of West Berkshire District Council on 30<sup>th</sup> December 2014.
- 11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
