








the UK	Made up of the countries; England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.	environment	The world around us.
observation	Noticing and looking carefully at an activity.	climate change	A major change in Earth's climate that is of current concern and which is associated with an increase in carbon dioxide and certain other gases in Earth's atmosphere.
temperature	How hot or cold it is. Measured using a thermometer .	carbon footprint	The total amount of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases produced by a single person, organisation, product, or process.
record	A written piece that shows past events.	thermometer	An instrument for measuring temperature.
