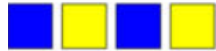

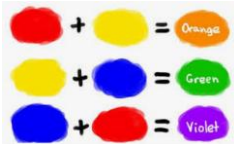

William Morris was born on 24th March, 1834. William Morris was famous for his printed designs. He used a block to make his patterns. His work was about nature and showed plants, leaves and flowers. He made patterned wallpaper.

Skills Knowledge

How to print:

- * 1. Choose an object and apply paint to one side of it.
- 2. SLOWLY press the painted surface of the object onto a piece of paper.
- 3. CAREFULLY lift off your object.
- 4. Repeat.
