Dear Parent/ Carer,

It has certainly been a great start to the week with lots to celebrate. On Monday, we found out how the Y4 children performed in the online multiplication check that they carried out two weeks ago. The children performed amazingly well with over 66% of the children scoring 25/25. The average score was 23.8, which is a school best score beating last year's 23.1. The national average for 2023 was 20.2 and the Wokingham average was 20.9.

Also, on Monday morning, the Y1 phonics pass mark was also confirmed and another school record was broken! 98% of Y1 children passed the check. In 2023, 91% of our Y1 children had passed the check and the national average was 79%. Well done to the children, staff and families involved! A special mention to the PTA who originally funded our move to the current phonics programme- Read, Write, Inc.

The Y6 SATS results are not released for another couple of weeks. I will update you with these once they are known.

This week, we are having some wall art installed in the hall and the library area on Wednesday morning. The wall art in the hall will incorporate the values mascots designed by the children in the mascot competition earlier this year. Thank you to the PTA for funding this.

On Thursday, we have our new EYFS cohort visiting again and on Friday, we have the Middle School Eid assembly to families taking place. This will be in the hall at 9am.
