

I hope that you all enjoyed the bank holiday weekend. The weather forecast for the week ahead is showing an improvement, so I will include some sun safety reminders this week.



Thank you to all of you that have responded and registered for this. We will be using this app to provide permission and make voluntary contributions on school trips in the near future, therefore registering for the app will be essential.

May Census Date: 16th May

A reminder that I am flagging this date as a day where we would like as many of the children in possible in Key Stage 1 and Foundation Stage to order a school meal. The proportion of children taking a universal infant free school meal is recorded by the government on this day. If not all meals are taken on this day, then a proportion of our funding for this is then taken away. Sun Safety

At this time of year, the UV level starts to climb and the risk of harm from the sun increases. As a guide to understanding UV levels, please see the table below:

UV index	Action
0 to 2	You can safely enjoy being outside!
3 to 7	Seek shade during midday hours! Slip on a shirt, slop on sunscreen and slap on hat!
8 and above	Avoid being outside during midday hours! Make sure you seek shade! Shirt, sunscreen and hat are a must

Usually at this time of the year, the UV level will be a minimum of 3 during lunchtimes, so we are strongly encouraging all children to bring in a hat and sunscreen (a minimum sun protection factor of 30 that the child can apply). Children may also bring a pair of sunglasses if they wish for lunchtimes. Please could any items brought in from home be named. We will also encourage children to spend at least some of their lunchtime in shaded areas.

We will monitor UV levels daily and if they get particularly high, we will provide a room or rooms (depending on the temperature and UV level) on that particularly day where shelter from the sun can be offered.

Any type of hat will always be preferential over no hat all. However, broad-brimmed, bucket style or legionnaire style hats offer the best sun protection as they adequately shade the face, neck, ears and cheeks.
