Dear Parent/ Carer,

Thank you for all of your donations to either CIRDIC or New Beginnings last week. A reminder that we will be collecting food and toiletries as part of Harvest Festival on Wednesday 15th October.

The week ahead is looking particularly busy with flu vaccinations on Thursday. On Friday, children can come into school wearing red clothes of their choice for 'Show Racism the Red Card.' After school, we have the PTA Diwali Fayre taking place.

Today, we had the Accelerated Reader parent presentation in the hall and I would like to emphasise the importance or reading at home with your child on a daily basis (even when your child is a fluent reader). Book talk and questions to help your child comprehend what they are reading is just as important as the steps that you took at home to support your child use phonics when they first started to read. During the presentation, we shared the following information as to why you should read with your child for 20 minutes a day.

Child A	Child B	Child C
Reads 20 minutes per day	Reads 5 minutes per day	Reads 1 minute per day
Hears 1, 800, 000 words per year	Hears 282,000 words per year	Hears 8,000 words per yea
Scores in the 90 th percentile on standardised tests	Scores in the 50 th percentile on standardised tests	Scores in the 10 th percentile on standardised tests

Obviously, this cannot be a one size fits all approach and each child's needs will vary. However, in the main, reading and discussing books with your child is the most effective type of homework that you can do with your child. This will help build their vocabulary and knowledge and the more frequent that you do it will lead to improved outcomes.

Accelerated Reader Parent Presentation

Alongside the weekly update this week, I am attaching a copy of the parent presentation for Accelerated Reader that took place in the hall today. Accelerated Reader is the reading scheme that is used after the Read, Write, Inc scheme. It is typically introduced for most children at varying points in Year 2 once they have completed the Read, Write, Inc scheme.
