Eco Council update - Big Birdwatch 2026

Eco-Council would like to draw your attention to the **Big Birdwatch 2026** that is happening this weekend (23rd - 25th January). **Big Birdwatch 2026** is organised by the RSPB (Royal Society for the Protection of Birds) and provides valuable information about how birds are doing in our gardens. As well as being beautiful creatures, birds are indicators about the health of our environment. They also contribute to the diversity of plant life through pollination and seed dispersal, control insect outbreaks, create important nesting areas for other species and help get rid of disease through scavenger "clean-up" services (magpies, crows and red kites).

By taking part in the **Big Birdwatch 2026** and observing birds in your garden, you will be contributing to national data collection of birds in our country, and cataloguing the number and types of particular birds. You will also get the chance to observe the nature in your garden, learn about different types of birds and even make bird feeders.

In order to take part, you need to register on the **RSPB Big Birdwatch 2026** website and they will email you an e-instruction guide about how to tally the birds you have seen, a bird identification guide and how to submit your data. The email link is below:

Attendance Update

Our current whole school attendance for the year to date is 94.5%, which is broadly in line with the national average of 94.6%. As a whole school, our percentile rank is 44 and we require your support in improving this figure. Well done to children in Y1, Y3 and Y5 as their attendance is within the top 33% of schools nationally. Attendance for Y6 children remains a concern as it is within the lowest 10% nationally when compared to other Y6 cohorts nationally.



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We have just completed our latest round of attendance monitoring and later this week notification letters will be sent out to most families where attendance is below 90%. Our process is to send a first letter to notify that attendance has dropped. When the first letter is reviewed, it will result in either a well done still monitoring letter if attendance has improved or a second letter. The second letter will ask families to arrange a meeting with myself, so that barriers to attendance can be discussed and a plan to move forward.
