#### Children's Mental Health Week - 3 -9 February 2025

Further to last week's update on this year's Children's Mental Health Week, I'm pleased to be able to share our plans with you all. Below is a breakdown of all the exciting things planned for our school community across the week:

- Mr Wieder will be starting off the week with an assembly to introduce the week to the whole school on Monday
- Throughout Monday Middle school will be taking part in an interactive Sport in Mind workshop in the
  hall. Sport in Mind aim to improve the lives of people experiencing mental health problems through
  sport and physical activity, and this workshop will be linked to Children's Mental Health Week.















- We will be hosting our usual Children's Mental Health Week coffee morning in the hall on Tuesday morning. This is open to all parents and will be hosted by myself and Mrs Blakely. We will also be sharing a presentation as normal. The hall will be open to parents from 8.50 10am and we'd love you to join us. Entry will be via the front office as normal for these events.
- On Tuesday and Wednesday FIRST Wokingham will be delivering their interactive "Engage the Rage" workshop to Upper School children over the course of the two days.
