#### Welcome to Foundation Stage Cohort 24/25

I would like to take the opportunity to welcome all children and families offered a place at Aldryngton a warm welcome. A reminder that places need to be accepted by May 1st.

Last week, all 45 places were once again offered to families that chose Aldryngton as their first choice. However, as we were informed by Wokingham, the number of children in the area has dropped considerably and the furthest child offered a place lived over one mile away. There is also a much-reduced waiting list in comparison to other years. A number of our neighbouring schools have been impacted considerably by this with a large amount of empty spaces for next year.

Schools are funded by the number of children that they have on roll in the October census day. Therefore, we need your support in continuing to promote the school to your friends and neighbours to ensure that we remain full in a time of surplus school places in the area.

# **Financial Update**

The budget for the current financial year has been the most challenging budget for the school to set in recent times. Aldryngton receives the minimum amount of funding that the school can receive from the government. In the 2022-23 financial year, we spent more than £50K extra than we received in income from the government and since then we have had to reduce the amount of staff further to balance the budget. In order to balance the budget for this financial year, we have been forced to significantly reduce the amount of funding in our curriculum resources budget to a minimal level.

Curriculum subject leaders have been asked to put together wish lists of any items that they would like for the school, but are unable to get because of the financial situation. I appreciate that these are challenging economic times for many people, however if anyone is able to support in anyway, then we will look to publicise some of these wish lists in the coming weeks. Thank you in advance for your support.

# Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 Sports Day

Please note that the Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 Sports Day will now take place at **2pm on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July,** rather than the morning time originally advertised.

#### Key Stage 2 Sports Day at Palmer Park- We Need You!

We are looking to finalise details for the Key Stage 2 Sports Day at Palmer Park shortly. As it currently stands, we would have an insufficient amount of staff to walk the children there and back like what we did last year. Therefore, the provisional plan this year, is to ask for as many children as possible to be dropped off and accompanied by a family member in the stand until they are registered by school staff















at Palmer Park at approximately 9:15am. We will also offer an option for some children to walk with a group of school staff that will leave at 8:30am. We will then look to run the event at an earlier start time if all of this is possible.

At the end of the event, the provisional plan is that we would be signing the children out who are able to be transported back out and then they are signed back in by the school office on their return back to school.

We also require a number of volunteers to support with the running of events e.g. scoring, getting children into lanes. The volunteers would be overseen by school staff. As there is likely to be a significant increase in vehicles, we would also require volunteers to support with parking cars on the overflow car park at Palmer Park.

To support with forward planning, I am attaching a brief survey to indicate if you could support in anyway. Please could this form be completed by all families with children in Key Stage 2 (Year 3- Year 6) by **Tuesday 30<sup>h</sup> April**. We will then be able to finalise plans and risk assessments accordingly. Please note that if we do have an insufficient number of volunteers, then we will need to consider running the event at school rather than at Palmer Park. Thank you in advance for your support.
