Dear Parent/ Carer,

I hope that you are all able to keep safe during the forecasted red weather warning over the next few days.

Yesterday, I had the pleasure of taking the chess team to the British Finals held in Nottingham. Prior to the tournament, we were one of the lowest ranking teams taking part in the competition. However, the children started really well winning two of the first three matches. This meant that at the start of round four, we were within the top four places. This then meant the final two rounds were against both the second and fourth ranked teams. The children did amazingly well, but lost these last two matches to finish joint 13th overall of all schools in the United Kingdom. It was a very long day on the trains and even tram journey in Nottingham as well! Well done to the team of Sricharan (Y3), Neil (Y5), Ronit (Y6) and Avyukt (Y4). EYFS Good Level of Development

Teachers in Foundation Stage have to make assessments as to whether a child is at the expected standard or not across a range of areas at the end of EYFS. The results of these assessments will be contained in the end of year report. Please note that the exceeding judgement was removed nationally several years ago. There is a national benchmark called a Good Level of Development (GLD). This is when a child at least meets the expected standard in all of communication and language; personal, social and emotional development; physical development; literacy; mathematics. The national average that passed this last year was 67.7%. At Aldryngton this year, 82% have met a Good Level of Development. This means that the school is likely to exceed both local and national averages this year.

Y1 Phonics Check

The Y1 Phonics Check pass mark (31) has been recently published. This means that 96% of children have passed at Aldryngton. The result for your child will be found in the end of year report.

Y4 Multiplication Check

The school received the results for this on Monday. Well done in particular to the 25 children who scored 25/25 this year. 82% of Y4 scored 22 or higher. Please note that there is not a national pass mark for this figure

Y6 KS2 SATS

We should receive the results of these assessments on the 7th July and I will look to update you on the school's results as soon as possible to this date.
