## Falling Numbers in Wokingham Borough Schools

I am writing to make you aware that there are currently a number of consultations taking place to reduce the planned admission numbers of a number of primary schools, both maintained and academies in the Wokingham Borough from 2026-27. Schools that are part of multi-academy trusts will run their own consultation.

For context, in 2024-25, there was a surplus of 19.5% (82 places) across the Earley primary schools alone and for next academic year, the forecast is 16.7% (70 spaces). Therefore, the consultations are aimed at reducing the surplus spaces figure towards 5%, which is considered optimum. As schools are funded on a per pupil basis, when schools do not have a full roll, it can cause financial difficulties.

At Aldryngton, we filled our spaces for 24/25 academic year, but have noted that the area that we are admitting from has become wider (over one mile away now). As communicated previously, we do not have plans to reduce our planned admission number currently.

## **MP Visit**

We have arranged for the local MP, Yuan Yang, to run an assembly on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December to share with the children what a MP does and how they are elected.
