Talk How can you grow 'good fruit' in your family?

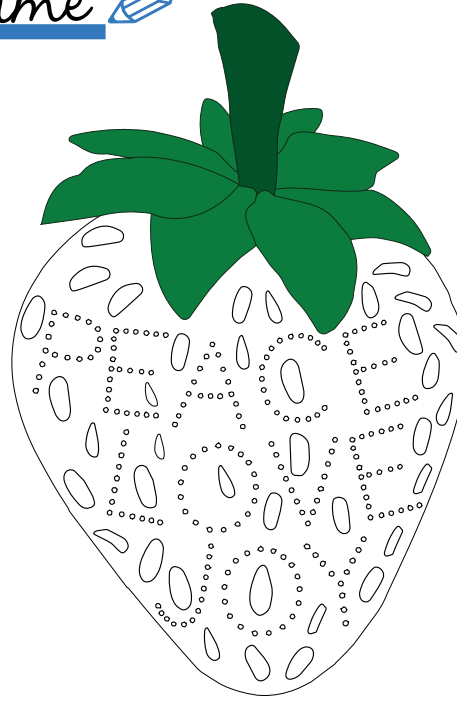
Do Find out how to plant a hyacinth bulb above water, so you can see the roots. Watch the roots grow over the next few weeks.

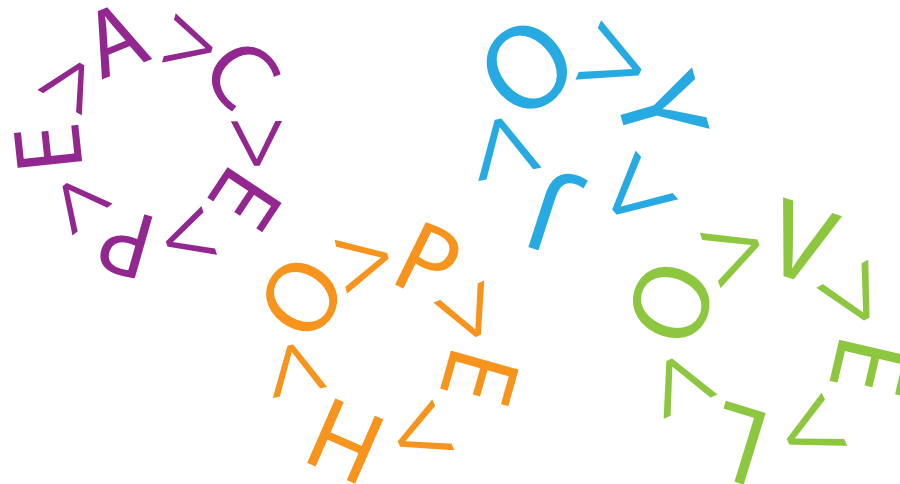

Circle Words. Work out where each of the four words start, then use the arrows to follow the circle around to find the words.

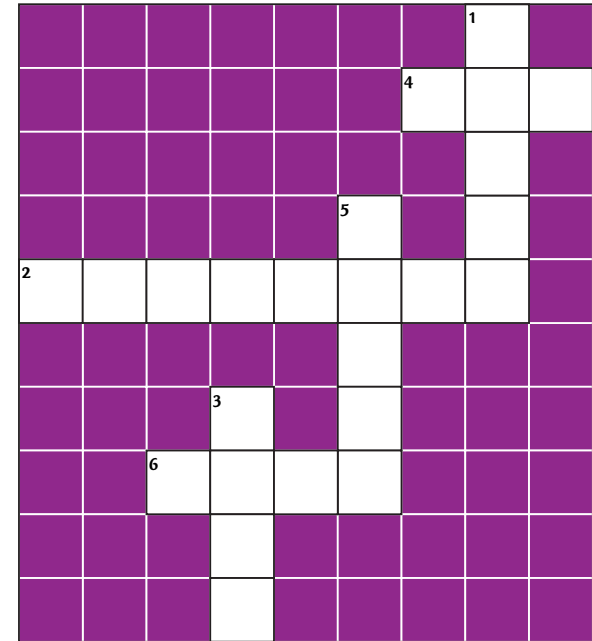
