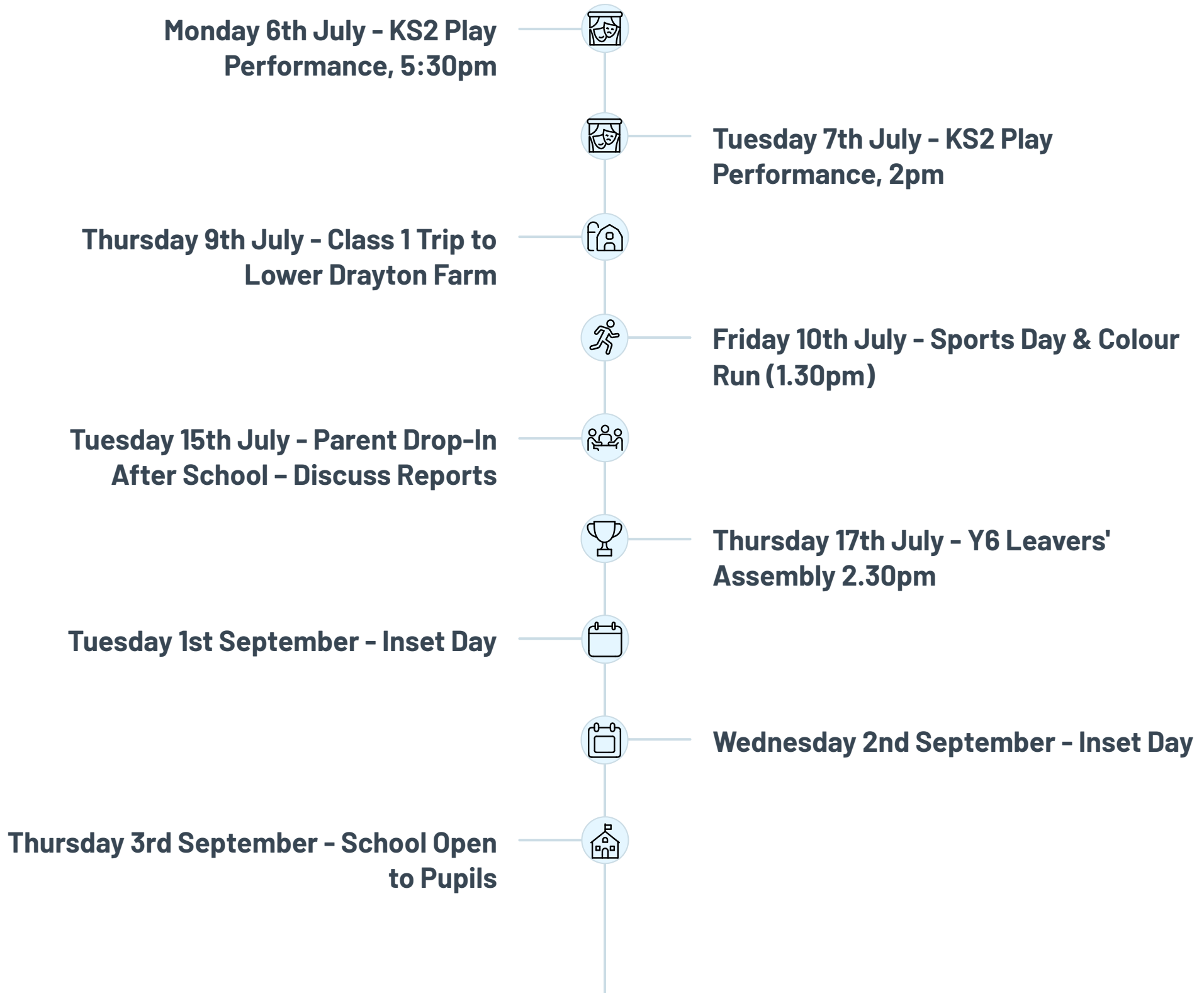
# **Swimming Update**
