Medical Appointments

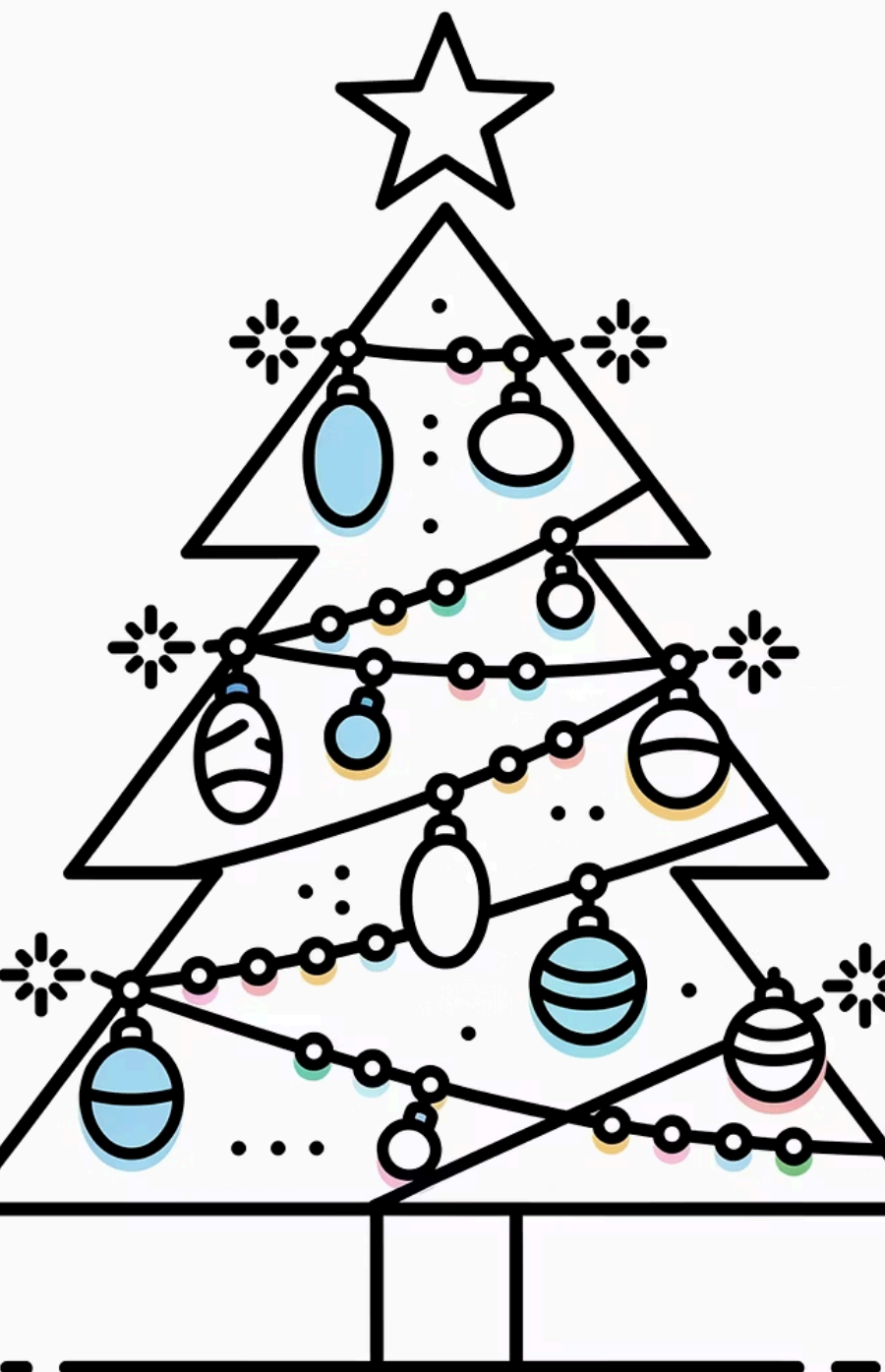
Where possible, please try to schedule medical and dental appointments outside of school hours. This helps minimise disruption to your child's learning and ensures they don't miss important lessons.
