Mathematics

The following maths facts are key for Y5/6. Learn the following facts:

$$10\text{mm} = 1\text{cm}$$

$$100\text{cm} = 1\text{m}$$

$$1000\text{m} = 1\text{km}$$

$$1000\text{g} = 1\text{kg}$$

$$1000\text{ml} = 1\text{l}$$

Can you work out fractions of the above? $\frac{1}{2}$ metre in cm?

English - Writing

Pupils will be given spellings every week based on the spelling pattern they have been learning about in school. **The spellings they will need to learn will be sent home to you each Friday** so that you can work on them with your child at home in preparation for a spelling test the following Friday. Assignments which follow the weekly spelling pattern, will be on Spelling Shed prior to the test. Please practise on there as much as possible. There are also **statutory spellings for Year 5 and 6** that do not follow specific rules. We will work on these in school, but if they could practise them at home too, that would be fantastic.

English - Reading

All pupils should be reading at least 3 times every week, with an adult or independently. **Please ensure you record any reading (this does not have to be their reading book) in their reading diaries.**

Reading books and diaries should be in school every day. Read 3x a week to earn 2 Dojo points.

Science

Our new topic is 'Properties of materials and changes'.

Can you find examples of reversible and irreversible changes?

Can you draw a diagram of fire and explain what is.

English

Copy out a poem of your choice, in your neatest handwriting. Can you illustrate it too?

OR

Write a setting description (for example, a forest, the beach, a haunted house, a fairground).

Write about the sounds you can hear, the things you can see, smell, taste and feel. Try to include lots of rich vocabulary and remember to punctuate carefully too!

French

Have a go at the worksheet on months of the year, in French!



History

Make your own Viking jewellery using cardboard, foil and gems. Why not make a Viking brooch or a Viking cuff bracelet?

Make a Viking longship or shield out of cardboard.

Create a large timeline of major events that occurred during the Viking era.

Create a fact file all about the Vikings.

Make a Viking village out of cardboard boxes, lollypop sticks, twigs, hay and moss.

Write down any recipes you use.
