Through our structured and inspiring programme, we help students understand the opportunities available to them, the skills required in the modern workplace, and the routes they can take to reach their goals.


Our CEIAG programme offers students meaningful encounters and experiences, including:

- Inspirational talks and workshops with guest speakers from a wide range of industries
- Mock interviews with local employers and professionals to build confidence and communication skills
- Workplace visits to experience different sectors first-hand
- Visits to colleges, universities and apprenticeship providers to explore post-16 and post-18
- 1:1 careers guidance meetings to support personal ambitions and next-step planning
- Lunchtime drop-ins with colleges, employers and careers advisers
- 'Meet the Employer' mornings offering insight into diverse industries and future pathways

We are proud that careers education at Alsop goes far beyond the classroom, it is embedded throughout the school and across the curriculum. Recently, our Year 11 students took part in mock interviews with over 30 different employers, gaining valuable feedback and real-world experience. Our Design Technology students had the opportunity to work alongside a Michelin-starred chef, learning about creativity, commitment and excellence in the culinary industry.

This year, we have also introduced our inspirational employer assembly theme, "What will your story be?" Each week, local employers and professionals visit Alsop to share their personal journeys, discussing their career paths, challenges and successes, while encouraging our students





to think about their own future stories. These sessions have been both motivating and thought-provoking, helping students to see that success can take many different forms.

Our careers programme develops year-on-year, supporting students at every stage of their journey:

- **Year 7 I Discover**: Exploring personal skills, qualities and attributes through Unifrog surveys & Ambition Events (see details below).
- **Year 8 I Explore**: Building aspirations and linking curriculum learning to real-world careers.
- Year 9 I Focus: Making informed GCSE option choices that keep future pathways open.
- Year 10 I Plan: Investigating post-16 options and understanding the value of qualifications and experience.
- **Year 11 I Decide**: Receiving 1:1 guidance, writing CVs and personal statements and securing post-16 destinations.
- Year 12 I Aspire: Exploring post-18 options, including university, apprenticeships and employment.
- **Year 13 I Progress**: Finalising applications and transitioning confidently to post-18 destinations.

This progressive approach ensures that every Alsop student is inspired, informed and equipped for their future. We are also proud to work closely with local employers, colleges, universities and training providers who share our commitment to preparing young people for success.

For your information **Unifrog** is an online platform used by our school, students and parents to help with careers, university applications, apprenticeships and general post-secondary planning.

What Unifrog is for:

- **Researching options:** Universities, courses, apprenticeships, colleges, careers & extracurricular opportunities.
- **Building applications:** Tools for personal statements, CVS, activity logs & teacher references.
- **Tracking progress:** Students can store achievements, skills and drafts in one place; teachers can monitor progress.
- **Comparing choices:** Side-by-side comparisons of courses, entry requirements & career pathways.
- **Guidance resources:** Videos, guides & quizzes about careers and academic choices.
