

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have managed to enjoy a restful summer break, it's hard to believe that the new school year is almost upon us. Please find below some important information about the start of the 2025–26 academic year.

On our results days, we were delighted to see a steady stream of students securing their preferred next steps. Many achieved the grades needed to progress to sixth form colleges, apprenticeship programmes or post-18 pathways such as university and higher-level training. Start of Term – Wednesday 3rd and Thursday 4th September

As per my letter in July, I have once again enclosed an important Information which gives you the full details for the start of term and key dates. In summary:

Wednesday 3rd September

Year 7 to arrive between 8am and 8:25am, in full school uniform, via the Walton Village entrance. The day will end after lunch at 1pm.

Year 11 to arrive for their scheduled appointment time for their 'Kickstart Mentoring Meeting'. It is compulsory for Year 11 students to attend the 15-minute meeting at School, accompanied by a parent or carer. Students are not required to attend for the full day and do not need to wear their unform to their allocated meeting, but they MUST attend their meeting. Please enter via the Music, Art & Drama building entrance. Year 11 parents/carers will have received a letter with your appointment time and arrival details for your meeting.

During the meeting, students will:

- 1. Set personal goals for their final 160 school days at Alsop
- 2. Review and strengthen their college applications
- 3. Reflect on their Year 10 report and agree next steps
- 4. Plan for the year ahead using key dates and available support
- 5. Discuss any barriers to learning and how we can help overcome them


Thursday 4th September

Parent Pay

We are currently experiencing a technical issue with setting up new ParentPay accounts for our new Year 7 students. Please be assured that this matter is being investigated and we are working hard to resolve the issue as quickly as possible. We will inform you as soon as the accounts are ready to use. In the meantime, there is no need to take any action or worry about your child's account. We will provide you with clear guidance once the system is fully up and running. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Mobile phone free school

As you are already aware, we have made the decision to make our school a phone-free school. This is aimed at supporting our students' well-being and enhancing their learning experience. The system we introduced ensures students can continue to have their phones for use on the way to and from school. For now, we will continue to enforce our we will enforce our "never seen, not heard" policy:

- If a phone is seen or used during the school day, it will be confiscated.
- Confiscated devices will be returned at the school's discretion, either to the student or their parent/carer.

This is the first step in fully implementing our mobile-free school policy. Over the coming weeks, I will share more about how we plan to further strengthen our approach to mobile phone use, always with the goal of supporting learning and enhancing student wellbeing.
