A Phone-Free School

We introduced the first phase of our mobile phone-free approach last year and I am pleased to be able to share details of the next phase ahead of the summer break. While we recognise that mobile phones have their place, particularly outside of school, they remain a significant distraction during the school day. Despite our current systems, we know that some students are still accessing their phones, which can impact learning, wellbeing and focus in lessons.

From September, we will be introducing a full phone-free system using secure pouches. This approach is already in place in over 3,000 schools and has been shown to have a positive impact on behaviour, engagement, academic performance and student wellbeing. I will write again before the end of the summer break with full details of how this will work when students return in September.

Thank you, as always, for your support in helping us maintain these high standards. As a reminder, if you need to contact your child during the school day, please do so via the school office.
