Dear Parents and Carers,

Ahead of the summer break, I am delighted to share details of our mobile phone-free school from September 2026.

While we recognise the value of mobile phones, particularly for the journey to and from school, they are a significant distraction during the school day. From September, we will be introducing a full phone-free system using secure pouches.

How it will work

- Students will be issued with a secure pouch to store their mobile phone during the school day.
- On arrival at school each morning, students will place their phone into the pouch and securely seal it. They will keep both the pouch and their phone with them throughout the day.
- During the school day, the sealed pouch must remain in the student's school bag or blazer pocket.
- At the end of the school day, students will unlock their pouch at designated unlocking stations as they exit the school site, regaining full access to their phone.
- Students are responsible for their secure pouch at all times. If a pouch is damaged, a replacement charge of £10.50 will apply.

We will take time to support students and clearly communicate expectations before the summer holidays. On return in September, students will receive a full induction, and the school will be completely phone-free from Thursday 3rd September.
