Students should arrive at school punctually each day and attend their morning tutor time, where they will receive final instructions for the exams scheduled that day. Any absent students will receive a phone call and potentially a home visit to escort them to the examination if no valid reason for absence is provided.

Students are expected to wear full school uniform each day, except on days when they have PE, in which case they may attend in full Alsop PE kit.
