Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing with the final update of the 2025 exam season, as Monday 16th June marks the start of the final week of exams for our Year 11 students.

Monday 16th June

All students should arrive at school at normal time and attend tutor time, wearing full school uniform or Alsop PE Kit.

Period 4 Spanish Booster class

At 10:45 the gate will be opened for students to leave the school site after their Science Trilogy Physics Paper 2 Exam unless they have Music or Spanish Booster Class. These two booster sessions are available to students who want to revise in school and have access to their class teacher. Music students will be expected to attend their booster class before their examination in the afternoon.

Students who remain onsite for the Spanish booster class will be allowed off site at either 12:30 or 2:00pm. Students completing their Music exam will be dismissed from the school site as soon as their exam finishes.

Tuesday 17th June

Only students who study Spanish should arrive at school at normal time and attend tutor time, wearing full school uniform or Alsop PE Kit

Students studying Spanish will be taken to the exam venues at 9:00am **GCSE Spanish Writing Exam**

Students will be dismissed from the school site as soon as their Spanish Writing Exam is finished.

Wednesday 18th June - Year 11 Leavers Assembly

Students should arrive via Student Services at the Walton Village entrance by 9:30am. The assembly will last approximately one hour and students will leave through the same entrance at 10:30am, marked by a special guard of honour.









Students are expected to attend in **full school uniform** or may wear **plain black PE bottoms with an Alsop PE top**. To mark the occasion, they are welcome to bring a spare shirt to be signed by friends and staff during the event. Please note that **students wearing non-uniform clothing will not be permitted to attend**, so we kindly ask for your support in ensuring they follow this guidance.

The assembly will be a chance for students and staff to reflect on their time at Alsop, share memories and celebrate this important milestone together. We hope as many students as possible will join us for this memorable event.
