



Provider Access Statement

Also High School is committed to ensuring that all pupils have access to impartial and high-quality information about a full range of education and training pathways, including academic routes, technical qualifications and apprenticeships.

This statement sets out how the school meets its statutory duty under the Skills and Post-16 Education Act 2022 (the *provider access legislation*).

Student entitlement

All pupils in Years 7 to 13 are entitled to:

- Learn about approved technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities
- Hear directly from a range of education and training providers
- Receive impartial information that supports informed decision-making about future pathways

The school ensures that pupils receive at least six meaningful encounters with technical education or apprenticeship providers across Years 7 to 13, in line with statutory guidance.

Opportunities for providers

Education and training providers are welcomed into school to engage with pupils through:

- Careers assemblies and pathway talks
- Careers fairs and employer engagement events
- Curriculum-linked careers activities
- Targeted sessions for specific year groups or cohorts
- Events for parents and carers

All encounters are planned to be age-appropriate, inclusive and impartial, and form part of the school's wider careers programme.
