<u>Developing skills and techniques</u> <u>for live performance</u>

- assessed internally using BTEC criteria for both practical performance and written logs, research and PowerPoint presentation.

Investigating Practitioners Work

- externally assessed and is a 2000 word critical essay. Learners take the assessment during a defined window and will be provided with an opportunity to re-sit

Group Performance Workshop

- will be the final externally marked unit taken in year 13 - students will be assessed for their practical devised piece and digital logs evaluating the process.
