#### **Positive Behaviour Reminder (PDR)**

#### **Be Ready**

- Wear the correct uniform and remove any outerwear
- Have your planner and timetable for the day
- Have the correct equipment for lessons

#### Be Respectful

- Respect everyone's right to learn; do not disrupt learning
- Respond positively to teachers' requests

#### Be Safe

- Move purposefully and safely around school; walk don't run
- Arrive to lessons on time
- Mobile phones and headphones should not be seen

#### **Positive Behaviour Reminder (Lesson)**

#### Be Ready

- Wear the correct uniform and remove any outerwear
- Have your planner out on the desk
- Have the correct equipment for the lesson or ask to borrow it

#### Be Respectful

- Respect everyone's right to learn; do not disrupt learning
- Respond positively to teachers' requests, including 321 STAR
- Engage positively with learning by trying your best

#### Be Safe

- Mobile phones and headphones should not be seen
- Only leave a lesson when permitted to by a member of staff

- Complete any homework that's been set
- Bring your planner and timetable

- Attend after school activities or a detention if you have one
- Leave the school site calmly via the main school gates

#### Be Safe

Travel home safely



- Uniform Issues (if no note in planner):
- Missing essential equipment:
- Boisterous behaviour (around school)
- Homework issue
- Chewing Gum
- Littering
- Earpods/Headphones

Conduct Reminders are recorded in planners.

10 Conduct Reminders in a week will result in a Detention.

First conduct concern; a reminder! Name recorded on Conduct Board







Second conduct concern; second reminder! Tick recorded under C2 on Conduct Board








Third conduct concern; final warning! Tick recorded under C3 on Conduct Board

This is a detention of up to 30 Minutes, with their Teacher.

Please attend! Or this will escalate to a Department Detention of 30 minutes.

Fourth conduct concern.


- On-call is alerted.

- On-call is alerted.

Also, an <u>Immediate</u> C4 can be issued for:

- Unsafe behaviour in the classroom
- Refusal to follow a reasonable request



#### C4 Detentions for Classroom Conduct



Fourth conduct concern.

- On-call is alerted.
- Student is escorted to Supervision Room.

C4 Detention is issued and supervised by Classroom teachers

Up to 30 Minutes in Duration (Teacher Discretion)

Routine notification to Parents through BromCom


Failure = escalation to Departmental Detention (30 Minutes)





# Supervision Rooms





Fourth conduct concern.

- On-call is alerted.
- Student is escorted to Supervision Room.

Supervision Rooms are other classrooms within the department/area.

A Supervision Desk will be allocated.


Students will complete their work and/or a Reflection Sheet.

Students are asked to return to their lesson at the end and <u>could have their</u> <u>detention rescinded</u>, if they engage positively with their teacher.



# Conduct in Supervision Room






Fifth conduct concern. Disruption in Supervision Room

- On-call is alerted.
- Student is escorted to Reflective Learning Centre for remainder of lesson.
- Student is scheduled for 1 Day placement in Reflective Learning Centre.



#### Conduct in Reflective Learning Centre





Sixth conduct concern. Disruption in Reflective Learning Centre.

- On-call is alerted.
- Student Suspended for half day.
- Student returns for 1 Day placement in Reflective Learning Centre.



#### Conduct around School / in Classrooms

A C4B is issued for other behaviour, in classrooms or around school.



These do not result in removal from the classroom.

A C4B Detention will be issued.

1 Hour Year Group Detention.


#### Examples:

- Truancy
  Smoking/vaping by association
- Out of bounds

### C4B Detentions for other conduct





A C4B is issued for other behaviour, in classrooms or around school.

C4B Detention can be issued by any member of staff

Year Group Detention (60 Minutes)

Routine notification to Parents through BromCom

Failure = escalation to SLT Detention (60 Minutes)

A C5B is issued for more serious behaviour, in classrooms or around school.

All C5B Incidents recorded will be investigated, fairly.

Depending on seriousness, these could result in:

Placement in Reflective Learning Centre

C5B

Examples:

- Dangerous behaviour
  Smoking/vaping
  Fighting/Violent Behaviour
  Threatening behaviour
  Verbal abuse of staff
  Prohibited item

- Persistent Truancy Persistent bullying
- Sexual misconduct
- Bringing school into
- disrepute Failing a C4B Detention
