Component 1: Human Lifespan Development

Component 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values

Component 3: Health and Wellbeing





Course Outline

<u>Year 10:</u>

<u>Component 1:</u> Human Lifespan Development (internally assessed / coursework based)

<u>Component 3:</u> Health and Wellbeing (externally assessed / examined component)

Reason for selection of components:

- Authentic links
- Full and robust coverage of examined component
- Allow students to maximise resit opportunities

<u>Year 11:</u>

Component 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values

<u>Component 3:</u> Health and Wellbeing – for those who need to resit

Reason for selection of components:

- Content builds on elements of component 1 and 3
- Complex terminology used in section of component 2





<u>Assessment</u>

- Health and Social Care is assesses both internally and externally
- Component 1 & 2 are assessed internally and combined equate to 60% of students' overall grade
- Component 1 or 2 also go through a standards verification process
- Component 3 is our externally assessed element; students sit a 2 hour exam and are allowed to resit twice if required
- The examined component makes up the remaining 40% of students' overall grade





Key learning habits for success in this subject

To be successful our students:

- Must always have a positive attitude to learning and develop their resilience
- Must listen carefully as we often discuss complex concepts
- Must apply their knowledge by acting on instruction and reflecting on class content
- Must be prepared to learn by having the right equipment
- Must arrive to line ups and lessons on time
- Must meet any deadlines for both coursework or homework tasks set
- Must always be polite and respectful of others views, opinions and feelings





What can I do to support my child?

- Encourage your child to complete the homework using their knowledge organiser
- Encourage your child to complete the sections in their homework booklet that are referenced to their knowledge organisers.
- Revise and revisit key factors and concepts, ideally at the end of a 2/3 week cycle
- Encourage them to meet any deadlines that are given to them for submission of coursework
- Reassure your child
