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Key learning habits for success in this subject

1) Ask questions

- 2) Use every opportunity to practice
- 3) Focus on the lesson, not the notes
- 4) Focus on balance: practice both spoken and written language
- 5) Independent learning- Download Duolingo, watch series on Netflix in Spanish.
- 6) Read as much as you can in Spanish
- 7) Improve your writing by revising grammar regularly and use GCSE Spanish workbooks
- 8) Reflect on your work : Identifying errors and making changes in response to your feedback.
- 9) Take a risk. Never be afraid to speak. You must have a go in order to improve your fluency and pronunciation
- 10) REVISE, REVISE, REVISE





What can I do to support my child?

You can support your child's language learning by:

- Doing plenty of repetition and practice as the key to success.
- Ask your child to teach you something in the target language.
- Buy books in the target language. Books are filled with varied but simple vocabulary and the basics of language structure and grammar. They offer the perfect foundation for learning the language.
- Try changing the language settings on shows on Netflix etc.
- Research with your child or encourage your child to research for themselves some of the similarities and differences between our culture and customs in UK and those in other
- countries.
