# **Introduction to the subject**

- BTEC Tech Award in Performing Arts
- Pearson BTEC level 1/2
- 3 components: components 1 and 2 are internally assessed and externally verified. Component 3 is externally assessed.
- Components 1 and 2 36 GLH
- Component 3 48 GLH





# **Course Outline**

### <u>Year 10</u>

Component 1: Exploring the Performing Arts Students will **explore** the processes used to create a performance.

- explore performance styles, creative intentions and purpose
- investigate how practitioners create and influence what is performed
- **discover** performance roles, skills, techniques and processes.

Component 2 : Developing Skills and Techniques in the Performing Arts Students **develop** performance skills and techniques by reproducing existing repertoire.

- take part in workshops, classes and rehearsals
- gain physical, interpretative, vocal and rehearsal skills
- apply these skills in performance
- **reflect** on their progress, their performance and how they could improve.





## **Course Outline**

### <u>Year 11</u>

Term 1 - preparation for external assessment Devising skills Working with a brief Mock assessment

#### **Component 3** – Performing to a Brief (released January 2023)

Students pull together all they have learned and **apply** their knowledge in a performance. Course completed May 2023





### **Assessment**

**Component 1** - assessed internally, externally verified. **30%** 

2 learning aims

Learning aim A - Examine professional practitioners performance work - research log

Learning aim B - Explore the interrelationships between constituent features of existing performance material – **PowerPoint** 

Component 2 – assessed internally, externally verified. 30%

3 learning aims

Learning aim A – Develop skills and techniques for performance – practical workshops and skills log

Learning aim B – Apply skills and techniques in rehearsal and performance – rehearsals and performance

Learning aim C - review own development and contribution to the performance - written log of milestone rehearsals

#### Component 3- Externally assessed – 40%

A devised performance in response to a brief release by Pearson in January 2023.

3 x 1 hour controlled assessments (written)

1 devised performance to be recorded for assessment.

All marked externally.
