Task 1 - Geography

This half term we are going to be learning about the 7 continents of the world. Create a poster about your favourite continent and include some interesting facts.

Task 2 - Writing

Create a booklet about your favourite bird and include some great facts!

Task 3 - RE

Can you create a piece of artwork that represents the Holy Trinity?

OR

Rewrite your favourite parable in your own words.

Task 4 - Science

We are focusing on materials - properties and uses. Conduct your own investigation after you have collected some materials.

- 1) How far can each material stretch?
- 2) Which material is the most waterproof?
- 3) Can you sort the materials into transparent and opaque?

Task 5 - Art

Can you create your own space-themed artwork, just like our focus artist Peter Thorpe?

Physical Education

In PE we will be focusing on dance.

Music

We will be following our Kapow scheme, focusing on singing. We will learning folk songs and create sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.

PSHE:

This half term, children will learn how to keep themselves safe, including understanding good and bad secrets, healthy boundaries, basic first aid and what to do in an emergency.

Science

In Science we will be looking at materials - properties and uses.
