

English

Through English this term the children will explore brochures and booklets with their final outcome to produce an information booklet for Tower Wood using their research and experiences during their residential. This will be followed by developing their debating skills in order to write a discussion text.

History

In History, we will be looking at the Ancient Egyptian civilisation including the importance of the river Nile, mummification, Pharaohs, and the Gods they worshipped. Our learning will be supplemented by the homework the children have this term and culminate in a visit to the Liverpool World Museum.

DT

Children will get the opportunity to taste and give opinions on a variety of new foods, they will experiment with different flavour combinations and design and make their own pasta salad.

Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will firstly focus on the classification of animals into groups before turning focus to urbanisation and its impact on nature.

Maths

In Maths this half-term, we will finalise our preparations for our Multiplication Check, before moving on to looking at position and direction, shape and statistics. At the end the year we will consolidate all our learning.
