

English
This half term, we will study the text 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo. Children will explore the storyline, looking in-depth at the different characters. They will then analyse the different skills that the author uses before planning their own historical story based on the same main character.

Religious Education
In R.E., we will begin by looking at the seven sacraments and how they are instrumental in Parish life. We will then investigate how the Gospel of St. John differs from the other Gospels by investigating a number of passages from scripture, looking at the differences between literal and spiritual meaning.

History
We will begin by recapping what they have already know about Roman and Anglo-Saxon invasions. They will learn who the Vikings were and where they came from. Children will gain an understanding of why the Vikings were successful in raiding Britain and will use their historical skills to develop the knowledge to answer the question 'Where do English people come from?'

Science
This term the children will be introduced to the idea that broad groupings, such as micro-organisms, plants and animals can be subdivided. They will discuss reasons why living things are placed in one group and not another. Pupils will find out about the significance of the work of scientists such as Carl Linnaeus, a pioneer of classification.

Computing
Our computing topic this half term is all about creating webpages. We will investigate what different elements of websites are, how they work and then create our very own.
