Nursery

This half term our theme is 'Sensational Seasons'. We will be exploring the British weather and comparing it to different countries.

The children will be using their senses to do lots of investigating as well as experiments to find out what materials are waterproof.

The core stories we are focusing on are:

One Year with Kipper by Mick Inkpen, Trees: seasons come seasons go by Patricia Hegarty and Betty and the Yetti by Ella Burfoot.

We are asking families to email a few photographs of your child playing in the different seasons. Maybe a beach holiday, splashing in puddles, out on an Autumn walk or building a snowman.

This half term our theme is 'Fantastic Fantasy'. We will be learning all about superheroes and fantasy characters. We will be talking about members of the local community who are real-life superheroes. We will learn all about Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale from the past and how they helped people.

In RE, we will be learning all about Advent and The Nativity Story. In the lead up to Christmas, we will spend time practising songs for the Nativity and writing letters to Santa.
