Spring 1 Topic - 'Our Wonderful World - At Home'

<p><u>Our Local Area</u></p> <p>Go on a walk in your local area. Talk about and take some pictures of what you can see. Can you draw a picture of something you saw in the local area? You could bring one of your pictures in to show everyone!</p> 	<p><u>My Home</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of your home. Can you draw your family inside too?</p> 	<p><u>Transport</u></p> <p>On a piece of paper, write the following modes of transport down (bike, motorbike, car, bus, tractor, lorry)</p> <p>With an adult, go outside and stand in a safe place on the pavement. Can you make a tally to show how many different modes of transport you see? Draw a line next to each mode of transport you see. After 10 minutes, go inside and count the total of each mode of transport you saw.</p>
<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Play throw and catch with a family member or friend. Every time you or your friend/family member catches the ball, you get a point. Count the points as you play the game.</p> <p>Can you reach 20 points?</p> 	<p><u>Remember, we have a special board in our classroom to display any learning you complete at home. Bring your learning linked to our topic into school to show us all! We can't wait to see it!</u></p>	<p><u>Maps</u></p> <p>Can you draw a map? Include roads, trees, buildings and our school.</p> <p>If you have a map at home, show it to your child and discuss what you can see.</p> 
<p><u>Transport</u></p> <p>Make a model of a vehicle of your choice.</p> 	<p><u>RE - Celebrating</u></p> <p>Talk about all the things we do to celebrate Birthdays. It is Bobby's birthday soon (our class teddy) and he would love you to make him a birthday card. Can you make him a card and we can give it to him on his birthday at the end of the half term?</p> 	<p><u>Objects in my house</u></p> <p>Say a sound to your child. Can they go on a hunt and find an object in your home, beginning with your sound.</p> <p>e.g. can you find me something beginning with 's'? (your child could find socks or a spoon)</p>
