In English this term, we will cover a range of grammar skills in preparation for our upcoming assessments. We will continue our writing unit using the novel 'Wonder'. The children will create a range of writing outcomes including a chapter for a novel, a biography, letters, diary entries, poetry and a discussion text.

RE

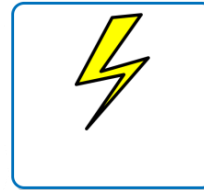
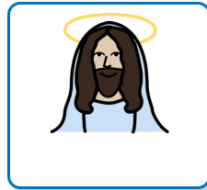
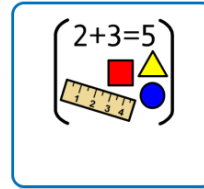
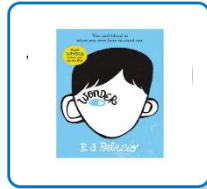
In RE, the children will be exploring how St John's Gospel connects the story of Jesus' Resurrection with the story of Creation in Genesis. They'll learn how Jesus, like Adam, appears in a garden, and how His rising from the dead shows that our relationship with God is restored through Him.

Art

In art, the children will continue to work on their fossil printing unit. They will investigate the colour wheel, focusing on contrasting and complementing colours. They will learn how to create print designs before using printing inks to create their final pieces of artwork.

Mathematics

This half term, Year 6 will be learning about:

- Statistics
- Shape
- Position and direction

Science

This unit's Big Question is: How can we vary the effects of electricity? Children will learn to link the brightness of lamps and volume of buzzers to the number and voltage of cells, compare how components work in circuits, and use recognised symbols to draw simple, accurate circuit diagrams.

SATs

This half term, the SATs will take place on the week of the 11th May. During the weeks prior, we will revise areas within reading, maths and grammar to support the children in their assessments. There will be no grid homework this half term, but children will receive paper homework linked to revision.
