Dear Parents/carers,

In September 2019, Ofsted updated their new framework for schools which has influenced the work we have done on the secondary curriculum this academic year. In line with the new framework, please find attached the revised Curriculum Intent for Samuel King's School. The revised curriculum intent offers students a broad and balanced curriculum and ensures there is full curriculum coverage at Key Stage 3 and 4. It allows students to broaden and deepen their knowledge and skills in Key Stage 3 and be fully prepared for GCSEs in Key Stage 4.

Also in line with the new framework, you will see that we have extended Key Stage 3 to include Year 9. We are still able to offer a variety of creative curriculum option subjects in Year 9 so students can begin to experience GCSE subjects and develop the required knowledge, understanding and skills to be successful in Key Stage 4 when they take the GCSE exams.

To support the new curriculum offer, we have made minor adjustments to the timings of the school day. We have extended the length of lessons to one hour and moved to a five lesson day. The beginning of the school day has been brought forward slightly to allow for a more punctual and productive start to the day. Many students are in school earlier than the current 9.10am start and we are keen to have them in lesson and learning from the start of the day. From September, the timings of the school day will be as follows:

8.55am-9.55am Period 1 (students to be registered in Period 1)

9.55am-10.55am Period 2
10.55am-11.10am Break time
11.10am-12.10pm Period 3
12.10pm-1.10pm Period 4
1.10pm-1.50pm Lunch time
1.50pm - 2.50pm Period 5


2.50pm – **3.15pm** Tutor and registration period and assemblies
