PERCENTAGES BASED ON 190 ACADEMIC DAYS

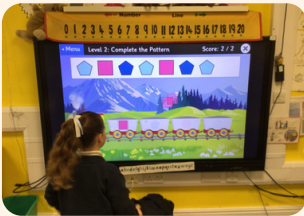

This week in maths, Year 1 have been learning how to count from 50 to 100!



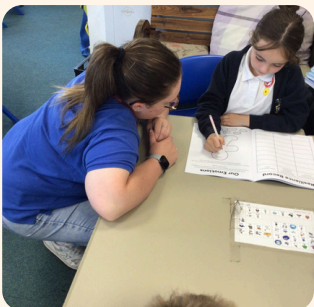
Year 2
