In Year 2 PE this week, children's dance skills have been amazing! Children have created a sequence of movements to music and performed a Winter Wonderland dance.



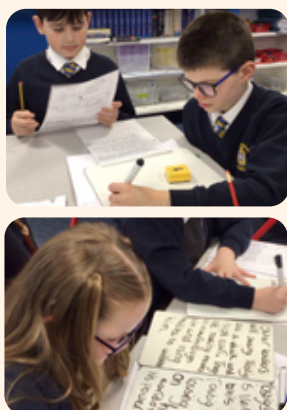
Year 3

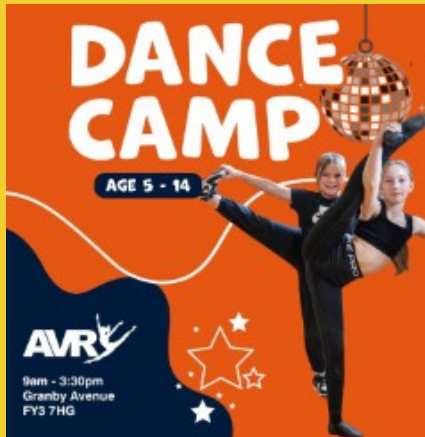
