## SAFETY MATTERS

This morning we experienced a “near miss” on the one of the roads surrounding school, which serves as an important reminder for us all to take extra care during drop-off and pick-up times.

To ensure the safety of our children, families, and staff we kindly ask that all drivers:

## FREE SCHOOL MEAL ELIGIBILITY

The UK Government has announced significant changes to the eligibility of Free School Meals from September 2026.

All children in England whose households receive Universal Credit will be entitled to Free School Meals, regardless of their overall household income.

All pupils that are currently receiving Free School Meals at this moment in time will be stopped from 31st August, and only those who re-apply will be eligible from September. This will be the case every year moving forward.

FSM will be 2 tiered: Targeted FSM - Those eligible under the old criteria (Universal Credit, earn less than £7,400) Expanded FSM - Anyone in receipt of Universal Credit (except those above)
