Here are your home learning activities for our United Kingdom topic that we will be starting after Easter. You need to choose at least 1 activity from the boxes below to complete over half term.

Your work should be beautifully presented and in your own words, you cannot just copy and paste from the internet. If you think of something different to those that are listed, check with your teacher and you could do that instead! All home learning should be brought into school on Monday 19th April to be shared with the class.

Create a brochure about Northern Ireland, Scotland or Wales to convince someone to visit. Include information such as:

- the weather
- Famous landmarks
- Rivers and mountains
- Tourist attractions
 - Population
 - Capital city
 - Culture

Research a famous landmark in the United Kingdom. Create a fact file about it and then produce a piece of Art or D.T work to go alongside it.



Find the recipe for an interesting, delicious-sounding or peculiar recipe from Northern Ireland, Scotland or Wales. Create the recipe for yourself and take pictures!

Choose one aspect of the United Kingdom (such as mountains, rivers, castles, landmarks etc.) and create a PowerPoint presentation about one or two from each part of the UK (Northern Ireland, Scotland, England and Wales).



Print out (or draw!) a map of the UK on a large piece of paper. Then, label as much as you can! Include capitals, cities, landmarks, mountains, rivers etc.

Plan a trip to either Northern Ireland, Scotland or Wales. How long would it take you to get there? How much would it cost? What sights could you visit? Where could you stay?

Have you ever visited Ireland, Scotland or Wales? If so, write a diary entry describing what you saw, where you visited and what you enjoyed!
