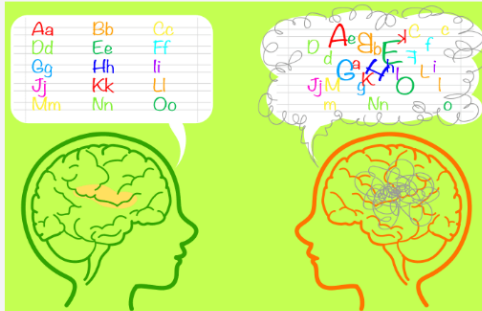


SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS AND DISABILITY (SEND)
