This is the national cycle marking and registration scheme aiming to reduce cycle theft and enable owners to be reunited with their stolen bikes when recovered. A bike that is marked with BikeRegister is 83% less likely to be stolen than an unmarked on.

To register a bike, the following details are needed: Bike Serial Number (Usually underneath the bike)
