BIKE MARKING: To coincide with Cycle to School week, Sally Adams, from West Lancs Council will be attending school on Tuesday 24th **September, 2.30pm - 4.30pm** to enable those with bikes (including parents) to register for FREE with the BikeRegister. This is the national cycle marking and registration scheme aiming to reduce cycle theft and enable owners to be reunited with their stolen bikes when recovered. A bike that is marked with BikeRegister is 83% less likely to be stolen than an unmarked on.

To register a bike, the following details are needed:
